This will be the ninth year that the Friends of Stoner Creek (FOSC) have held their annual fundraiser on this site, although this is the first year it has been called Paris Landing. It is located at the end of Chambers Extended.

The Creekside picnic is a fun-filled, wholesome family event. It's a great opportunity to visit with your friends and enjoy Stoner Creek. Pontoon boat rides will be available throughout the evening.

Picnic food will be provided by Brian's Paris Landing, starting at 5:30. Kids eat free if accompanied by an adult.

This year, no food or drink can be carried onto the picnic grounds. Water will be provided, and you can purchase soft drinks, beer and wine.

Also new this year, parking will be off site in designated areas. Good thing you don't have to carry anything onto the grounds. Food, drink and chairs will be waiting for you at Paris Landing.

Tickets may be purchased in advance for just \$20; at the gate they will cost \$25. Children under 12 get in free.
